Manuscript penmanship – neatness and correct letter formation

Cursive penmanship – neatness and correct letter formation

Writing different types of sentences with correct capitalization, punctuation, and grammar-

Place value and number sense (knowing the 10 digits, reading and writing numbers, understanding ones vs. tens vs. hundreds vs. thousands place)

Comparing numbers, equations and patterns (<, >, or =; least/greatest, smallest/biggest, number patterns)

Addition and subtraction up to 4 digits (basic equations and word problems)

Time and Money (reading a clock, understanding a.m. vs. p.m., recognizing coins/dollars and their values, adding/subtracting time and money)

Fractions (comparing fractions with like denominators or like numerators, understanding fractional parts of a whole, arranging fractions in order, recognizing how to simplify a fraction)

Area and Perimeter (understanding the difference between Area and Perimeter and when each is used, knowing how to calculate Area and Perimeter)
