Grammar-

Eight parts of speech

(Noun, verb, adjective, adverb, preposition, pronoun, conjunction, interjection)

Writing-

Manuscript penmanship – neatness and correct letter formation

Cursive penmanship – neatness and correct letter formation

Writing different types of sentences with correct capitalization, punctuation, and grammar-

(Declarative, interrogative, imperative, exclamatory)

Reading-

Math-

Place value and number sense (knowing the 10 digits, reading, and writing numbers, understanding ones vs. tens vs. hundreds vs. thousands place)

Comparing numbers, equations, and patterns (<, >, or =; least/greatest, smallest/biggest, number patterns)

Addition and subtraction up to 4 digits (basic equations and word problems)

Time and Money (reading a clock, understanding a.m. vs. p.m., recognizing coins/dollars and their values, adding/subtracting time and money)

Fractions (comparing fractions with like denominators or like numerators, understanding fractional parts of a whole, arranging fractions in order, recognizing how to simplify a fraction)

Decimals (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division using numbers with decimals)

Area and Perimeter (understanding the difference between Area and Perimeter and when each is used, knowing how to calculate Area and Perimeter)
