2023 Homecoming Policies and Dress Code

REGISTRATION & ATTENDANCE PROTOCOL

- 1) All students planning to attend must fill out and turn in a student registration *along with the fee for their tickets*. Tickets are payable in advance via check or online or at the door (\$20 CASH) and are **non-refundable**.
- 2) Any current GHA high school student or graduate may attend.
- 3) This is a **closed event** – no student or alumni will be allowed to leave and then return. Students must arrive at the dance no later than 7:15pm, and they may not leave until it is over at 9:00pm.

***This is a semi-casual event. Students are encouraged to wear appropriate attire. If you arrive at the dance not in dress code, you may be asked to leave.**

DRESS CODE

Ladies:

- Casual pants and jeans are allowed. Any pants must be free of excessive wear or holes above the knee.
- Dress length must meet the minimum requirement for the uniform skirt (just above the knee).
- Spaghetti-strap, halter, and strapless dresses are NOT permitted (straps must be at least 1 inch wide).
- Tops must provide full coverage in the front. Bare midriffs, bare backs (below the bottom of the shoulder blades), and any other “holes” in the dress are not permitted. Sheer or “see-through” fabric over any part of the body required to be covered (midriff, lower back, etc.) is not permitted.
- Excessively tight or form-fitted clothing is not permitted (this includes skinny jeans, jeggings, or yoga-style pants).
- Shoes must remain on the feet the entire evening. Sandals must have a back strap. Tennis shoes and boots are allowed.
- The GHA Student Handbook rules regarding hair, makeup, and any other issues not covered in this description must still apply.

Gentlemen:

- Appropriate fitting casual pants or jeans are allowed. All pants must be free of excessive wear or holes.
- Collared or casual shirts must also be free of excessive wear or holes. No pop-culture references are permitted.
- Excessively tight or form-fitted clothing is not permitted.
- Shoes must remain on the feet the entire evening. Tennis shoes and boots are allowed.
- The GHA Student Handbook rules regarding hair and any other issues not covered in this description must still apply.

DISCIPLINARY ISSUES

In the unlikely case, that a student commits a violation in the following areas, s/he will be asked to leave the event immediately and parents will be notified.

- 1) Offenses involving possession/use/intoxication by any drug, alcohol, or tobacco product
- 2) Failure to follow chaperone instructions, or responding to such instructions with disobedience or disrespect
- 3) Failure to follow required attendance protocol, dress code, or etiquette policies
